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

#### Inhalt:

The courses in this module comprise a reflected revision of basic facts and findings for students who took their BA degree in English and American Studies at the FAU, but they also deal with selected advanced prob-lems of synchronic and diachronic linguistic description and analysis.

The module is strongly recommended for students without FAU's BA degree in English and American Studies as they will be familiarised with the concepts taught at FAU.

The seminar Topics in Linguistic Theory offers an overview of various linguistic subdisciplines and their approaches, taking a theoretical and descriptive as well as a synchronic and diachronic perspective. It is the aim of this course to illustrate various theoretical approaches towards the analysis of language, for instance, structuralism, generative linguistics and usage-based theories.

The seminar Topics in Language Acquisition Research focuses on developmental aspects of first and second language perception and production. Students will discuss different theoretical and methodological approaches to the study of language acquisition, analyse phenomena characterizing first and second language acquisition and discuss recent findings of neurolinguistic and psycholinguistic research.

#### Lernziele und Kompetenzen:

The students will acquire and improve their knowledge in core linguistic disciplines, among them the

They gain insights into the developmental similarities and fundamental differences in first and second language acquisition. They learn how to assess and criticise theoretical linguistic concepts in the light of findings of neurolinguistic and psycholinguistic research.
